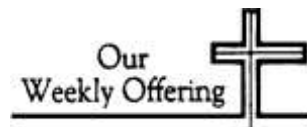

St. Joseph 150th History

Pipe Organ - Part of Parish Life from Church's Beginning

Activity to install an organ in St. Joseph Catholic Church was in motion even before the church was dedicated on Aug. 2, 1908. A "Saengerfest", a concert of choral and instrumental music, was held inside the church on July 29, 1908 to raise funds to benefit the organ fund. All of the church choirs in Shelbyville participated in the event that was under the direction of Frank J. Rembusch.

Rev. Adelrich Kaelin, pastor, and a representative of the M. P. Moller Organ Co., of Hagerstown, Maryland signed a contract July 29, 1912, for the sum of \$4,200 for the purchase of a two manual, 21 rank instrument. Parishioners provided half of that money for the purchase and the Andrew J. Carnegie Corp. gave the remainder. Martin B. Chenhall dedicated the organ on Feb. 4, 1913 with a recital that included an orchestra and chorus made up of united choirs of all Shelbyville churches. Rembusch directed the event.

It became obvious in the late 1960s that the organ needed repairs. Rev. Bernard Burgert accepted bids for the work, however, budgetary limitations prevented it. By 1977, major repairs were needed. The Parish Council approved the formation of a committee to raise funds for repair. The fund drive started in August 1977, but suffered a delay because of the unexpected death of Father Edward McLaughlin. Rev. William Ernst was appointed pastor of St. Joseph. He signed the contract for the organ repairs on March 2, 1978. The work was scheduled to occur in the spring of 1979. The old organ was last used for Mass on Easter, April 15, 1979. It was dismantled the following day and reintroduced during Mass on Aug. 12, 1979. The restored organ was rededicated on Sept. 12, 1979 to commemorate the birthday anniversary of Fr. McLaughlin.

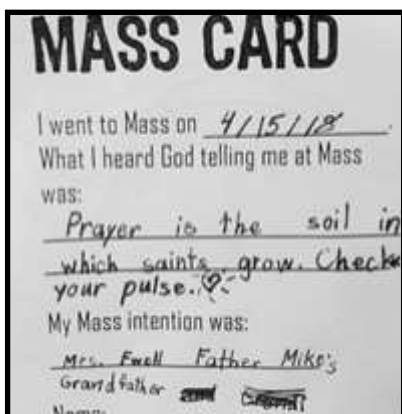
