

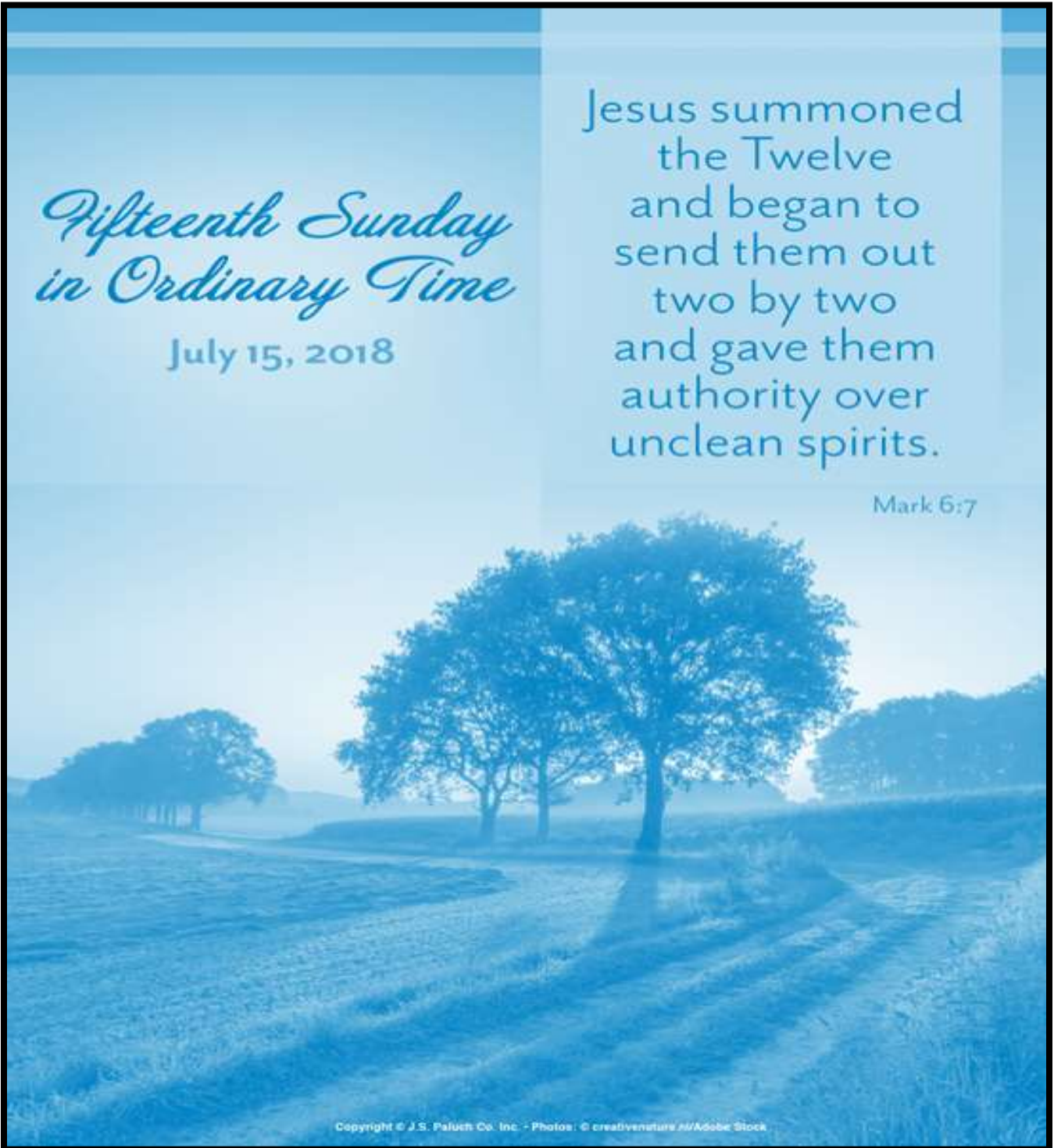

## Ask Seminarian Owen Duckett

**Q.** *What do we call the new seminarian?*

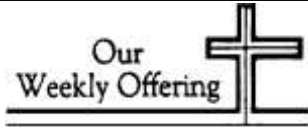
**A:** At my home parish (Holy Rosary in Indianapolis) the parishioners usually refer to me as "Seminarian Owen" so I am comfortable with that if you are looking for a formal title or simply "Owen" in a casual setting.

**Q.** *I see several people leaving Mass early. Is that okay?* Karen M

**A:** Unless a true emergency would present itself (use your best judgment) it is not okay to leave Mass early and to do so is quite frankly a direct insult to our Lord. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the timeless re-presentation of the very Sacrifice that Christ made for us during His bitter agony and suffering which constitute His Passion. There is an infinite amount of grace available to us at every Mass, and our Lord literally becomes present on the altar under a new substance that is His Precious Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. The Mass is the greatest prayer of the Church and we were directly instructed by our Lord Himself to celebrate this Sacrifice. If after considering all of that one still feels inclined to simply "grab-and-go" each Sunday and head for the door after receiving Jesus in the Eucharist, then perhaps that person should sit down and seriously examine the nature of his or her relationship with Almighty God and His Holy Church. Leaving Mass early conveys a disinterest and lack of care for the action taking place, an action which directly concerns the salvation of our souls. This is a simple and kind admonishment, not a threat or a way of saying we do not want you at Mass. In fact I do hope that you come to Mass (and stay through its duration) because I want you to go to Heaven. The Mass is the closest thing to Heaven on Earth, the intersection between the Divine and the whole of creation. It is the one place where you can take your week's problems, cares, anxieties and cast them on our Lord. Do just that, and stay even ten or fifteen minutes afterwards to offer your thanksgiving for all that He has to offer you. If you find yourself not getting anything out of Mass, consider first what you are giving of yourself each Sunday (how am I preparing, participating, praying?). Our Lord is not a burglar, He is a guest. He will not force His way into your life but will only show His power when welcomed. Feel free to attend my talk on July 17th concerning this topic titled "How to Get More out of Mass".
