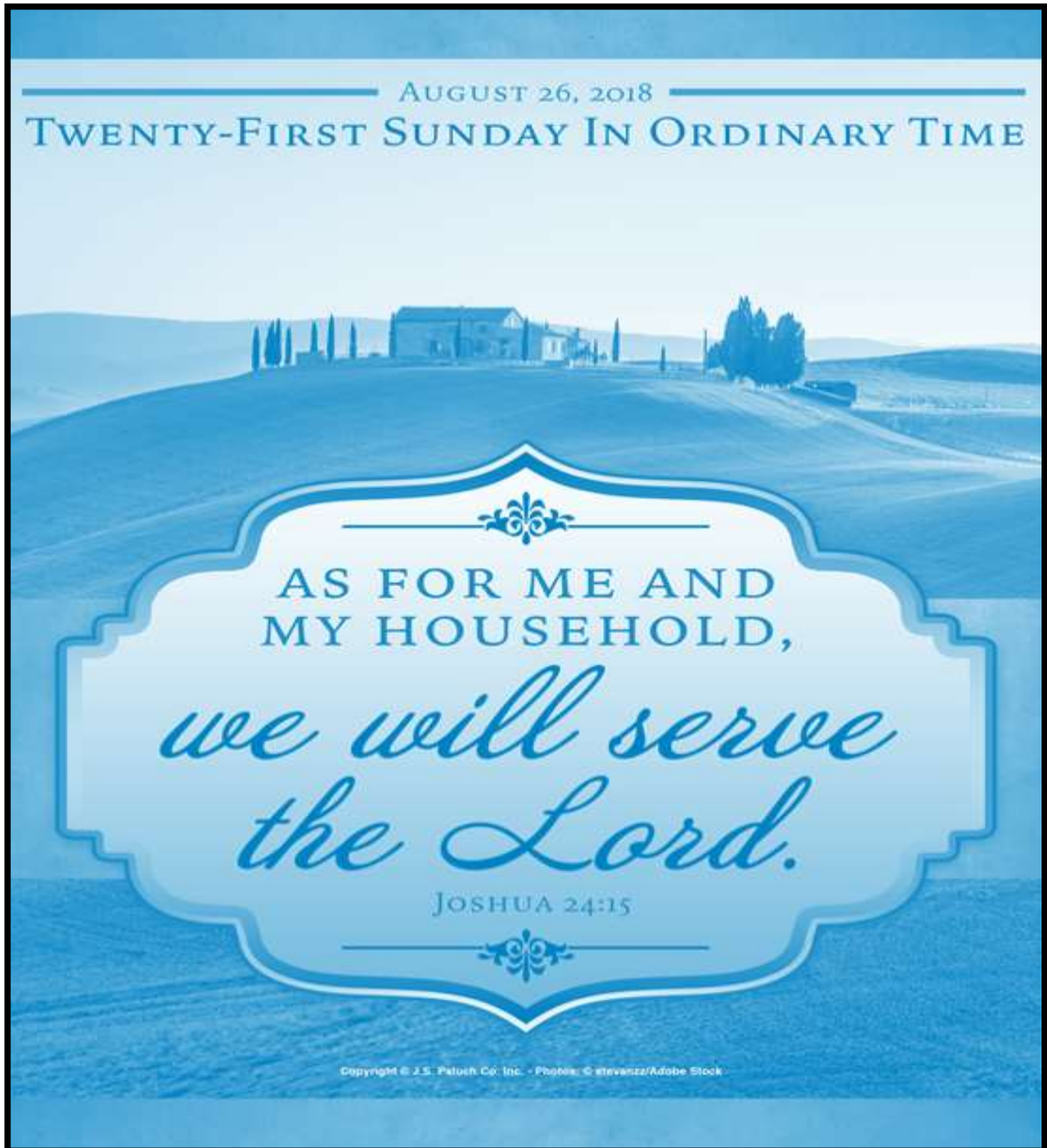

From the Desk of Fr. Mike

Dear Friends,

RCIA begins very soon. There are a few different types of people who come to RCIA. There are 1) those who have never been baptized, 2) those who were baptized in a Protestant denomination but want to become Catholic or at least think about it, 3) those who were baptized Catholic but fell away, often before Confirmation or even First Communion, and 4) those who simply want to learn more. All are welcome at RCIA!

We start RCIA on Monday, September 17th at 7 pm at St. Vincent. Like last year, we are doing RCIA as a joint parish effort this year. It worked out so beautifully last year.

The other day I met with someone who told me her grandfather became a Catholic at his deathbed. Someone asked him, "Why didn't you become Catholic before?" He said, "No one ever asked me." The power of an invitation! 75% of Shelbyville has no religion folks....we should invite our friends and family to think about our beautiful faith and join the family! Folks can just come that night or can fill out a registration form that can be found under the Faith Formation Tab at www.stjoeshelby.org.

Annual Report: Hopefully, by the time you're reading this, you have received the annual report from the St. Joe office. It tells a wonderful story of God's grace this past year at St Joe! Please take some time reading it all. Let's pray this year is just as great!

Confirmation: We had a great turnout at the first Confirmation prep meeting last weekend. Over 20 youth. A reminder: if you have an incoming freshman or another youth who might have missed the Confirmation boat, let us know...it's not too late to sign up. We also had a great retreat with the other group, who will be confirmed very soon.

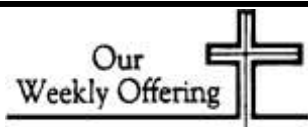

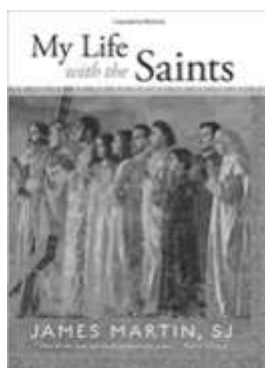
