From the Desk of Fr. Mike

Dear Friends,

We have about a month before November, the month of All Souls—one of my favorites! It is time for us to think about our St. Joe Cemetery and get it ready for All Souls Month.

We are blessed at St. Joseph and St. Vincent to have parish cemeteries. Many parishes don't have one. It is good that we do. But, like everything, a cemetery requires maintenance. A few months ago we started discussing our cemetery at Parish Council. I want to update you on this.

Recently, work began on the fence. A gentleman worked long and hard to get that project going. He made a lot of progress (he had to sand away the rust first, and then repaint it), but then had to stop for various reasons. Other parishioners volunteered their time out there also. They patched the big pothole and have been trimming the bushes and weeds.

Work still must be done. Billy had the good idea that our youth can help out, and that perhaps we can have a Fall Work Day soon to tackle those projects and some projects here at church. He thought perhaps we could invite the youth but also everyone who wanted to help out.

We will have our work day on **Saturday, October 20th**. I hope everyone can come and work, even if for a short spell. I especially want our cemetery to be beautiful for All Souls Month. By the way—we will have the annual cemetery prayer service and grave blessing on **Sunday, November 4th, right after the 10:30 am Mass**. Put it on your calendars.

Confirmation Mass for our Confirmation candidates is this Wednesday at 7 pm at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral. All are welcome to come and support our young people. All in all, we have about 60 candidates this year from our parishes.

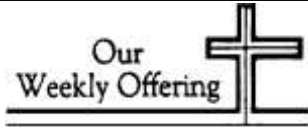

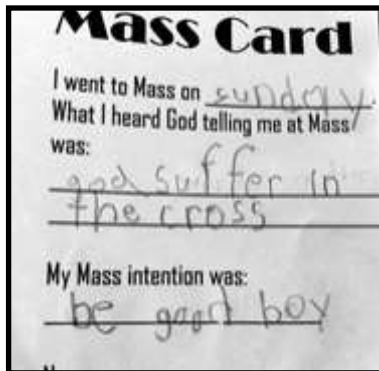

Mental Illness and Families

The dignity of the individual is paramount in our belief that we are all created in the image and likeness of God. Our language should reflect that belief. When talking about mental illness, we need to use "people first language." We refer to people as the persons they are - not the disease they have. So we say "a person who has a mental illness" or "a man or woman with a mental illness." We avoid referring to people using terms like "the mentally ill" or "the depressed." As people of compassion and justice we should never use stigmatizing language or demeaning terms.

Careful use of language is more than being "politically correct." It is a way of communicating that people with mental illness, as Pope John Paul II said, "have the inalienable right not only to be considered as an image of God and therefore as a person, but also to be treated as such."

In the Gospel reading this Sunday Jesus says, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me;" These words should cause us all to pause. How do we as a country receive children?
